



North Fulton Athletics Indoor Game Protocols



Due to changes in IDPH guidelines regarding spectators **North Fulton will now be allowing spectators at athletic contests beginning February 16, 2021.** Each student participant will be given tickets prior to each contest. Spectators must have filled out the information on the ticket in order to be allowed into the buildings. No spectators will be allowed in the building without a ticket. **Because of the physical restrictions of the individual gyms in the co-op, the number of spectators allowed varies depending on game location and sport. Please see the chart below to see the allowable number of spectators for each type of event .**

Wildcat Spectator Guidelines

- Spectators must be family members (18 years or older) of student participants
- There will be no cost of admission for spectators
- Spectators should arrive at the school no more than 15 minutes prior to the start of the game
- Temperatures and symptom checks will be taken at the door upon entry for all spectators. (100.4 or above and/or symptoms will result in no admission to the game).
- Masks must be worn by all spectators at all times
- Spectators are expected to sit in only the assigned spectator rows of the bleachers at spots 6 feet from the next spectator group. Spectators should not congregate with other family groups.
- Spectators can sit in pairs with family members in attendance
- Concessions will NOT be available. You may bring your own water to games. There is also a “hands free” bottle filling station available at Cuba High School. Please do not bring food to the games.
- Restrooms will be available
- No visiting spectators will be allowed to enter. At this time there are no schools in the conference or region allowing visiting team spectators.
- Once admitted to the contest, spectators will be asked to stay. If you have to leave the school for any reason, you will not be admitted back into the building.
- If guidelines are not followed, individuals may be removed from the event

The following game protocols are already in place and will remain:

- Home games will continue to be streamed live through the North Fulton YouTube channel. <https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCSnFneemzbA3CBpa-ns8zJA>
Information about how to view away games will be available on both districts' websites and social media as it becomes available
- Visiting coaches will certify they and members of their team are COVID-19 symptom free and have been screened per IDPH guidelines before arrival to an event.
- No visiting fans will be allowed into the gym at this time. Only individuals that are necessary for competitions (athletes, coaches, officials, etc) will be allowed in the building.
- All players, coaches, and workers will be expected to maintain social distancing, sit with their own group or team and stay at least 6 feet away from other groups. We ask that visiting teams enforce these parameters on their own team personnel. By IDPH guidelines, masks are mandatory at all times by all those in attendance.
- The only workers allowed at the scorer's table will be the home team bookkeeper and clock keeper. A separate table or area will be set up for the away team's book keeper.
- Locker rooms will NOT be available. Please come wearing uniforms underneath clothing attire.
- We will be following sport specific guidelines and mitigations from IDPH, IHSA and IESA such as sanitation of equipment, sanitation of scorers table, etc.
- Visiting teams will be asked to bring only personnel and players that are essential to each team in an effort to minimize the number of people at the event. We may enforce a limited number of student-athletes to meet appropriate guidance.
